The Baltimore City Democratic State Central Committee is accepting resumes to fill a Central Committee Member vacancy in Legislative District 43A. Central Committee Members are elected by a process that recognizes three gender categories: female, male, and non-binary. There is one (1) male vacancy in Legislative District 43A. Non-binary applicants are also eligible to apply.

Applicants should possess the following qualifications:

- Be a registered Democratic voter in the State of Maryland; and
- Be a resident of Legislative District 43A.

Interested applicants should email a resume (attached as a PDF) to <u>baltimorecitydems@gmail.com</u> and indicate District 43A in the email subject line. Resumes must be received via email by no later than <u>5:00 pm on *Friday, January 31, 2025*</u>, for consideration. Resumes must include your full name (no nicknames), full address, email address, and phone number. Resumes received after the deadline will not be considered.

Interviews for eligible candidates will be conducted via Zoom on *Wednesday*, February 5, 2025, by the seven (7) voting members of the Legislative District 43A. Applicants will be notified of their specific interview times. The interviews will be live-streamed on the Baltimore City Democratic State Central Committee Facebook interviews page, allowing the public to view the in real-time. (https://www.facebook.com/baltimorecitydems - a Facebook account is not required to watch the live stream).

After the interviews have concluded, the seven (7) voting members of Legislative District 43A will vote publicly. The individual receiving the most votes will begin immediately and serve the remainder of the term, which concludes in November 2026.

Description of Position:

This volunteer position offers the opportunity to build the Democratic Party in Baltimore City, increase voter turnout and register voters. In addition, in the event of a state delegate and/or senate vacancy, the full voting member will vote to fill the vacancy. The individual selected is expected to attend monthly Baltimore City Central Committee meetings, Maryland Democratic Party meetings, and participate in Central Committee activities. Central Committee members are the grassroots volunteers of the Maryland Democratic Party.
